2006 Cabernet Petit Verdot

Challenging weather conditions in 2006 led to ideal ripening conditions and resulted in exceptional fruit quality. This wine shows outstanding fruit concentration and excellent varietal definition.

Vibrant, dark red with purple tones in colour, this wine has all the classic hallmarks of an Australian Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot wine. An intense bouquet of varietal fruit flavours combine elegantly with the supporting notes of coffee and coconut.

The palate is an array of juicy blackcurrants and plum jubes with overtones of blueberries and violets. The generous fruits are rich and supported by subtle oak flavours and finishing with a soft tannin structure.
